## Carrier Updated Scheduling Instructions

Updated April 2023

### Overview

Starting April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2023, Nordstrom is making an adjustment to the routing methods for suppliers shipping less than truckload (LTL) to Nordstrom locations. The PO shipments going to Nordstrom locations will now be routed through Nordstrom Transportation team for specific states and DC destinations.

This will be a phased roll out:

States to Go Live on 4/24/2023 include **DC, DE, MD, ME, Upper NY, PA, and RI**. Refer to the Nordstrom Routing Guide for instructions specific to each state page you are shipping from.

States to Go Live on 5/08/2023 include **ID, Northern CA, NV, OR, and WA**. Refer to the Nordstrom Routing Guide for instructions specific to each state page you are shipping from.

States to Go Live on 5/15/2023 include **AL, AR, GA, SC, and TX**. Refer to the Nordstrom Routing Guide for instructions specific to each state page you are shipping from.

States to Go Live on 5/22/2023 include **AK, CO, FL, IL, IA, KS, LA, MA, MN, MS, MO, MT, NE, NH, NM, NC, ND, OK, SD, VT, VA, WI, WV, and WY**. Refer to the Nordstrom Routing Guide for instructions specific to each state page you are shipping from.

### Updated Routing Instructions

- Suppliers must send pick up requests to **LTL@nordstrom.com** for verification and routing confirmation based on the instructions for each state you are shipping from.
- Suppliers fill out our Nordstrom Request Form with shipment details for scheduling
- LTL shipments will be tendered via the TMS to carrier for acceptance and scheduling
